



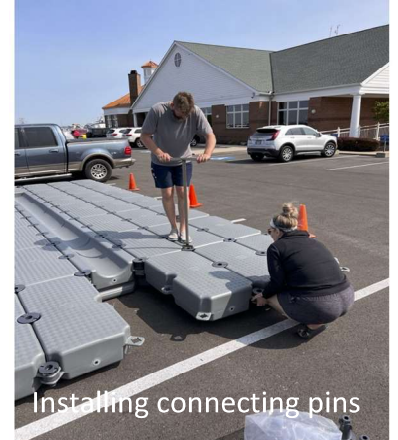
An Actual Customer's Installation Of A Drive On Lift For 21' Switch Boat



Dock parts arrive on pallets



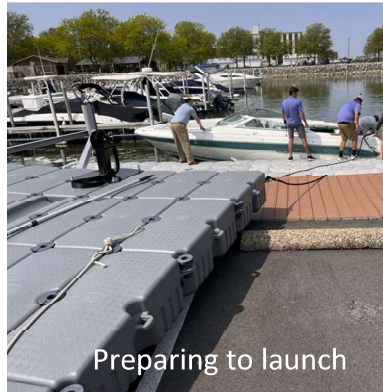
Floats laid for assembly

Completed boat lift



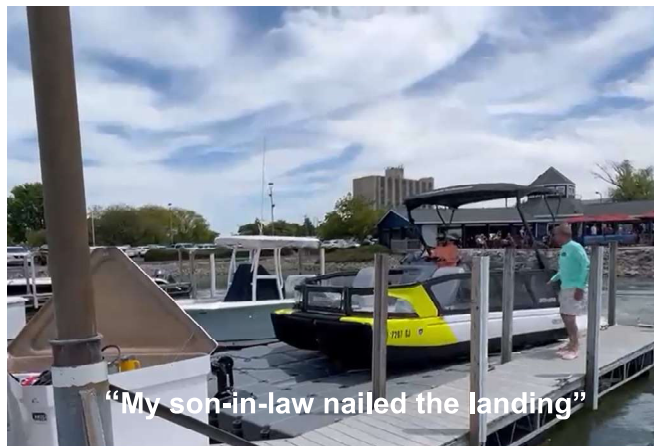
Preparing to launch

We unpackaged it, inserted the plugs while on the pallets, and put the pieces on a small trailer to transport them across the parking lot to an open spot near the water. The directions were easy to follow. We laid it out to ensure all the pieces were there and placed in the correct order before installing the connectors. From unwrapping, to completion, ready to launch, took about 2 hours and 10 minutes. A power boat owner offered to pull it into the water and then the dockmaster pulled it to the dock with the small marina boat. In our marina, the dockmaster has to do the work to attach anything to the docks. He did a great job of attaching the dock connectors for us. We'll put the Switch on it later this week.
